Jack the Horse

For all its upscale bohemian charm and perfect little brownstones, the picture-book neighborhood of Brooklyn Heights could use a few more restaurants like Jack the Horse—a homey, exposed brick tavern that’s been kept under wraps by the locals who frequent it.

Who would want to share this gem? With its bright, window-lined walls and impossibly delicious cocktail list, this place would be a destination spot even without Tim Oltmans’ gorgeous American fare like a savory artichoke, pancetta “cheesecake” starter topped with tomato-caper relish and crispy greens; creamy pan-seared hake with sweet red peppers, zucchini, chorizo, and plantains, dancing in a tomato cilantro-lime broth; or silky coconut panna cotta studded with crunchy sesame seeds.
